Wisconsin Inmate Education Association (WIEA) has been tasked with launching **Operation Transformation: an in-prison college curriculum to transform inmates, families and communities.** It is a collaboration among WIEA and Trinity International University (TIU) to establish a Trinity campus within the Waupun Correctional Institution. WIEA is responsible for its' planning, fundraising and implementation.

This unique campus provides a Bachelor of Arts in Biblical Studies program for inmates serving either many years or life sentences. In our second year, we have 40 students enrolled. Upon graduation, these men become "field mentors" who are available to be peer counselors to other inmates either at the Waupun Correctional Institution or other correctional institutions where they may be located in the future. Each year our program will grow by 20-25 new students.

We would like you to consider contributing to WIEA's second annual fundraiser which will take place on **Wednesday, September 25th, 2019 at the Sharon Lynne Wilson Center for the Arts.** We will move the conversation from the classroom, to the prison, and into the community. We will be inspired by the first public viewing of a video with two of our students. We will hear about how a prison culture can change dramatically by introducing 4 graduates into their facility from a Texas Warden. And we will experience a Morning Star production created for our evening.
